The successful candidate will also work in collaboration with the Lead S&C Coach in the delivery of S&C services to the professional and 2nd XI squads.

Using high quality interpersonal and communication skills, you will work in collaboration with staff to conduct a battery of fitness tests, track workloads, effectively report results, agree recovery strategies for players, assist with injury rehabilitations and work closely with coaching staff to ensure player development plans align with performance goals.
