The world famous Trent Bridge Cricket Ground in Nottingham will host the Specsavers Test - England v India, 18 to 22 August

Arriving by bus or tram

The most convenient tram stops for Trent Bridge are Nottingham Station and Queens Walk, both a 20 minute walk away. Spectators travelling by car can take advantage of seven free park and ride sites across the city. The closest to the ground is Clifton South (17 minute tram travel time) stopping at Meadows Embankment, which is a 20 minute walk along the river to Trent Bridge, or travellers can stay on-board and travel to Nottingham Station. As an added incentive to use the tram Nottingham Express Transit (NET) are offering a £2 return event ticket for all match and season ticket holders. Please purchase the £2 event ticket at any of the tram stop ticket machines and have it to hand, along with your match ticket, should it be requested by a travel officer. If you have any problems purchasing the ticket, please use the help point provided on the side of the ticket machine.

International match ticket holders who use the tram can also take advantage of a free shuttle bus service which will run for the first three days of the Test. The service, run in partnership by Skills Coaches and NET, will depart from the bus stop on Arkwright Street, which is a short walk away from Nottingham Station's Queens Road or main exits. Buses will drop off near the Embankment, Trent Bridge, which is just a few minutes stroll over the bridge to the ground. Buses will leave Arkwright Street bus stop from 09:00am and run every 10 minutes until the match starts at 11:00am. The return service will pick up at the Embankment bus stop from the end of play and run every 10 minutes for one hour. Non tram users are also welcome to use this service for just £2 return.

There are many buses that connect the city centre to Trent Bridge Cricket Ground via Nottingham Station and from the city. The most frequent services operate every few minutes from Monday to Saturday. Look out for the Nottingham City Transport buses 1,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10 and 11, which stop in the city centre and outside the station.

The Trent Barton services Mainline, Rushcliffe Villager, The Cotgrave and The Keyworth, will also get you there, along with the Kinchbus 9, the Centrebus 19 and the Marshalls 90.

You can buy a Robin Hood day ticket on all bus services passing the Cricket Ground for £5. For more information visit www.robinhoodnetwork.co.uk

The **FREE** Robin Hood Network integrated transport app can be downloaded from the Google Play store or itunes. It gives real time information from your bus stop and lets you know exactly when the next bus is coming.

Audio and visual announcements inside all buses will inform you exactly where to get off.

Please note that there are no trains running between Derby and Nottingham until Monday 3 September due to Derby resignalling work. A rail replacement bus service will operate in its place. Nottingham Train Station is around a 20 minute walk from Trent Bridge.

Driving to Trent Bridge

Using the Park and Ride (P&R)

If you are travelling from further afield then using one of the many tram, train or bus-based P&R sites might be the best option. **N.B. Queens Drive P&R closes at 8.30pm and Racecourse P&R closes at 7.30pm with last buses to both sites going from the city at 7pm.**
