IMPORTANT NOTE

1. Only subscribing members of the club are eligible for election and shall have been a member of the club and entitled to vote for a period of not less than two years prior to election.
2. No person who is an employee of the club or of any body which is controlled by the club may be a member of the General Committee nor propose or second anyone for it until three years have elapsed since ceasing his/her employment with the club.
3. Proposers and seconders must be subscribing members of the club who are entitled to vote.
4. It is desirable that only those members willing to serve if elected should be nominated.
5. You may include a statement overleaf, not exceeding 100 words, giving your personal opinions and policies on which election is sought.
6. Any person who, in the opinion of the General Committee, brings the club into disrepute shall, at the discretion of the General Committee, be disqualified from holding office in the club.
7. Any member seeking election for the first time to the General Committee will be required to submit the nomination before 5.00pm on 1 November. The candidate will then be invited to meet members of the Nominations Panel. This meeting will enable candidates to learn much that is required of the members of the General Committee in terms of time and commitment and would provide an opportunity for questions and discussion about the responsibility involved.
